On behalf of the Chicago Dermatological Society (CDS) and its board of directors, I am writing to request your participation as an exhibitor for our upcoming conference on September 11, 2019. The exhibit fee for this meeting is \$1,750; exhibitors who register and pay for at least three meetings in a fiscal year are offered a discounted registration fee of \$1,500 per meeting. Vendor displays are situated prominently to assure the opportunity to interact with our members. In addition, of course, all exhibitors are recognized in our meeting materials.

The September monthly conference will be “hosted” by the Department of Dermatology at Loyola University, and it will take place at Stephens Convention Center in Rosemont, IL. The meeting is accredited for Category 1 Continuing Medical Education credit. The speaker is Stephen E. Wolverton, MD. He is the Theodore Arlook Professor of Dermatology at the Indiana University School of Medicine in Indianapolis, IN.

Registration and the exhibit area begins at 8 a.m., and the lectures start at 9:00 a.m. The conference adjourns for the day at 2:00 p.m. Typical attendance is about 200 dermatologists (including about 50 dermatology residents). The exhibit area is open throughout the meeting and is completely separate from CME activities.

The primary mission of the Chicago Dermatological Society – as a not-for-profit organization incorporated in Illinois – is to provide educational opportunities for dermatologists in the Chicago area.
